

Dexter Township Resolution # 18-517

A resolution to adopt ballot proposal language for a five-year, 1.4586 mil Police Services millage renewal and to approve the August 7, 2018 Election for the proposal.

Whereas, the Township Board of Dexter Township wishes to continue to provide police protection and law enforcement services; and

Whereas, townships may provide police protection and law enforcement services, as authorized by Public Act 33 of 1951, MCL 41.801; and

Whereas, townships may contract and cooperate with other entities to provide police protection and law enforcement services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

Whereas, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

Whereas, the Township Board of Dexter Township wishes to renew up to a 1.4586 mil levy to provide police protection and law enforcement services;

Be it therefore resolved, that the Township Board of Dexter Township, Washtenaw County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 7, 2018 Election ballot: *Police Services Millage Renewal*

Shall Dexter Township renew the previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution of up to 1.4199 mills (\$1.4199 per \$1,000 of taxable value), for five (5) years, 2019 through 2023 inclusive, for police services, including, but not limited to: Contracting for police services; hiring police officers and related staff; purchase and or lease of police vehicles and equipment; construction, purchase and or lease of facilities for police operations; contracting for dispatch services; and any and all other services related to police activities within Dexter Township, raising an estimated \$555,434.00 in the first year the millage is levied.


