**Subject:** Dexter Township Electronic Community Warning System Information - First Transmission

Hi Dominic,

I am beginning to forward the following information relating to the recommendations that we discussed relating to the electronic warning system to cover residents of Dexter Township. This will help eliminate any potential problems due to file size, etc.

- [Updated Federal vs. Whelen Comparison – first transmission](#)
- RF propagation study which outlines the coverage you can expect to get from the control point to remote siren sites in the township. If you read the propagation map as well as the note from Broadcast Engineering, who completed the review, you will see it is anticipated that remote siren sites will need a radio capable of 25-45 watts of power as well as good antennas in order to transmit reliably back to the control point from the remote siren sites. In the bottom of Ken's report you will see an explanation of the colors identified in this RF study.
- Recommendation Letter
- Surewarn Map which reflects the coverage provided by the siren sites we have chosen to provide coverage to your community.

As I have stated during both of my opportunities to present to the public safety committee, service on the system is always an important consideration. I identified our service capabilities in the comparison I provided during our last meeting. One thing I forgot to mention is that we have service technician who lives in Brighton Township within 14 miles of Dexter Township. Ken is well versed in all aspects of the Federal Signal warning system including control point, RF, and programming. Again, I believe this is a benefit that sets us apart from our competitors.

I look forward to hearing back from you with your thoughts after you have had an opportunity to review the information that I provided.
