**PUBLIC COMMENT/INPUT POLICY**

1. Members of the public wishing to speak shall sign in with their name and address.
2. Speakers shall address the Zoning Board of Appeals from the front table/lectern and begin by stating their name and address.
3. Speakers are encouraged to be as factual and brief as possible and to restrict comments to the application and property under consideration.
4. Speakers shall address all comments and questions to the Chairperson. Discussion, questioning, or answering between members of the public may be ruled out of order.
5. Each speaker shall be limited to three minutes. Petitioners or their representatives and a speaker representing a group shall be limited to five minutes. Speaking Times may be extended by the Chairperson.
6. Speakers may address the Zoning Board of Appeals more than once, but subsequent comments must bring new information, correct the record, or raise new questions.
7. If there are numerous people in the audience who would like to comment on an issue, and it is known that all share the same opinion, it is requested that a spokesperson be selected to speak for the entire group. If this arrangement cannot be made, it may be necessary for the Chairperson to restrict each speaker to a limited time in order that all may be heard.
8. Members of the Zoning Board of Appeals may question any speaker to gather information.
9. Off-topic comments and interruptions from members of the audience shall be ruled out of order.
10. Public comment on action items shall take place during the public hearing for that item. Public comment on non-agenda and non-action items shall take place during the public comment at the beginning and end of the meeting.
