Western-Washtenaw Area Value Express (WAVE) is a nonprofit service organization established in 1976 that exists to provide affordable transportation for older adults, persons with disabilities and riders by choice within western Washtenaw County.

Directs WAVE Operations

- Write WAVE policies and procedures
- Be resourceful and collaborate with respective teams to quickly solve performance challenges
- Maintain relationships with MDOT, AAATA, other funders and community partners
- Maintain organized and accurate records for MDOT / AAATA
- Complete and file AAATA and State of Michigan Reports
- Serve as a communication link between the Board, employees and service users
- Serve as WAVE's spokesperson
- Participate in WAVE Board and committees
- Participate in strategic planning
- Manage and report on agency insurance matters
- Prepare and maintain financial records, contracts and other materials for the accountant and auditing team

Organization Leadership

- Advocate for positive organizational change by understanding and promoting emerging organizational models and demonstrate how they support and improve WAVE operations
- Manage employees and their function within the team
 - Recruit, interview, hire, supervise, assess and terminate staff
 - Develop, present and/or arrange staff training events
 - Maintain the WAVE Handbook, and keep internal policies up-to-date and compliant with State and Federal requirements
 - Oversee employee participation in offered insurances and other benefits (i.e. Delta Dental, Heritage Vision Plan and IRA)
 - Prepare payroll and maintain employee records
 - Manage pre-employment screening and drug and alcohol screening
- Become trained as WAVE's Designated Employee Representative (DER) through MDOT
